

A Parent's Guide to Cub Scout Day Camp

Who can attend?

- Any registered Cub Scout or WEBELOS Scout may attend.
- Parents are encouraged to volunteer one or more days with their Pack.
- We advise that siblings do not attend Day Camp, as they are not permitted to participate due to insurance reasons.

Registration process

- Your Pack's Camp Coordinator should provide you with two information forms, one for your scout and one for you. Complete these forms and return them with your son's registration fee.
- The Coordinator will take care of registering you and your son online.
- B.S.A. Health Form, Parts A&B are required for all scouts and adults attending camp.

Preparing for Day Camp

- Your son will be provided with a t-shirt to wear every day to camp.
- You may purchase a t-shirt for yourself ahead of time or at the camp trading post.
- Each day you should send a packed lunch and water bottle with your scout. (Refrigeration is not provided).
- You and your scout must wear appropriate footwear to Day Camp. Only closed toed shoes will be permitted.
- Sunscreen is recommended for everyone.

Medication at Day Camp

- If your son will need medication at Day Camp, you must turn it in to our First Aid Staff. Please be sure to bring the original prescription bottle and have it in a zip-lock bag, clearly marked with scout's name and unit number.
